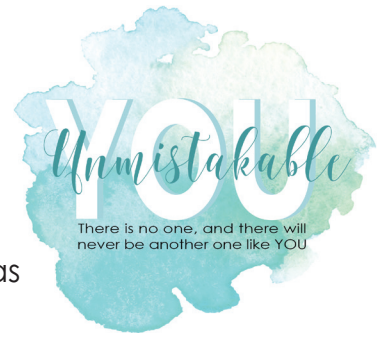


4. Looking Back

Print out four or five photos from the events that you have chosen from the year you were born. To make if more personal, choose some that resonate with you, ones that mean something to you rather than a random event.

For example, if you happen to love Disney movies and you were born in 1966 then you might want to mention it was the year he died.

On another note if you were born in 1969 you probably would want to highlight this major event that has shaped history - it was the year man first walked on the moon.
