

Discover the pristine beaches, turquoise waters and villages of remote Fiji on this seven night cruise aboard the fully accommodated MV Reef Endeavour Cruise Ship. Cruise departs and returns to Denaru Marina Nadi.

The MV Reef Endeavour explores parts of Fiji that the larger ships cannot get to. We will visit remote villages, churches and schools and take part in traditional village ceremonies, Meke (dance) and Lovo feasts.

In addition to being immersed in Fijian culture, this custom designed itinerary will still give you plenty of time for relaxing on warm white sandy beaches, swimming, kayaking or even paddle boarding in crystal clear waters. Plenty of snorkelling and glass bottom boating (for those not as adventurous) over amazing coral reefs. The ship is equipped with a hydraulic platform ensuring boarding and disembarking the glass bottom boat is easy.

Stay on board and be pampered by the ships Day Spa, or simply relax on the sun deck the jacuzzi or pool or grab a cocktail at the pool bar.

Dining is another vital ingredient, so whether it is an alfresco luncheon a casual BBQ or table d'hote dinner, all food is prepared onboard from fresh local and imported produce. All meals are provided in the cost of this cruise.


Sample itinerary inclusions:

- Visit some of the most remote islands of Fiji situated to the North of the Mainland - being volcanic in origin they offer some of the most dramatic scenery in the South Pacific
- New islands and coral reefs to visit every morning and afternoon
- You will have the opportunity to experience a special choral church service and visit a local school where we can bring and hand out supplies that are much needed.
- A possible visit to the famous Dateline—180th Meridian—where you can literally stand with one foot in today and the other in tomorrow. (dependant on itinerary confirmation)
- You will be able to explore these pristine environments with our Marine Biologist and expert guides. Snorkelling, kayaking, exploring the caves and meeting the locals of these amazing settlements
- Daily opportunities to snorkel or swim. Itinerary will include the chance to swim in caves, aquamarine limestone lagoons and adjoining coral gardens in pristine waters.
- One evening visit a village to enjoy the tastes of Fiji with a traditional “lovo” (earth oven) feast where we share fresh local seafood, meat, succulent tropical fruits. Then dance to the drum of the meke(dance) and kava ceremony... and more

Final islands and itinerary will be confirmed at a later date once we know the cruise will go ahead and together with Cruise Line will see how much of my bucket list will fit into this cruise. However, I can assure you it will be spectacular for both water and culture lovers and will be visiting remote islands that are not visited by larger ships.

RATES are fully inclusive of accommodation, ALL meals, snorkelling equipment, glass bottom boat tours, island tours and village walks, use of all ship board facilities and evening entertainment.

Reef Endeavour Ship Layout

Accommodation: MV Reef Endeavour has 63 recently refurbished Tabua Suites, Staterooms and Cabins.

Every cabin type features a private bathroom ensuite, on/off air-conditioning, hair dryer, 240 volt power, international shaver point, Pure Fiji soaps, shampoo & towels serviced daily. Each cabin is approximately 14sqm. Tabua Suites are approximately 28sqm. Staterooms and Suites open onto the outside deck and have two windows.


Tabua Suites (4) feature a bedroom (twin/double) with ensuite bathroom, plus a separate day room with, chair, settee, desk, TV & DVD player, refrigerator, tea & coffee facilities and second bathroom.

Connecting Family Staterooms (6) located on A & C decks (twin/double)

"B" Ocean Stateroom (33) located on A and B deck

"C" Ocean Staterooms (16) located on C deck

"D" Porthole Cabins (10) open onto an inside passageway (twin/double/bunk triple/bunk quad).




Sun deck

All rooms have twin beds convertible to double bed unless indicated as follows:



There is NO lift.


Therefore you need to be mobile to climb stairs between the floors. Please consider this when choosing your cabin.




B Deck




C Deck



D Deck






FAMILY OCEAN STATEROOM

The FACTS

Fiji is open to tourists from 1 December, 2021. And we have this awesome opportunity to have this vessel all to ourselves. We have only a handful of cabins left for this to be a totally private charter cruise.

A non refundable deposit of \$400 per person is payable as soon as possible to Geelong Travel to confirm your booking. They will then advise when final payments are due.

This is a special VIP cruise and we have received an awesome deal with cabins heavily discounted as you can see by the normal prices shown on previous page. SCRAPBOOKING WORKSHOP PORTION: There will be a minimal additional fee to be confirmed. As this ship is smaller than the usual RCC cruises offered and we will be in different locations morning and afternoon, scrapbooking classes will be made OPTIONAL onboard and mainly held at night. There is nighttime entertainment but not what you are used to on the larger ships. Further details on the workshop side and classes that will be available at a later date. However a dedicated space is available for those not wishing to go ashore or swim, allowing you to scrapbook during the day if you wish. Therefore for those wishing to participate in the workshops there will be a small additional scrapbooking fee covering welcome gift and inclusive of one or two classes. Other kits/classes will be optional and an additional cost - You will be able to choose these in advance.

FLIGHTS to Fiji and ACCOMMODATION prior to cruise are currently out of range. These will be quoted later.

If by some chance the cruise doesn't go ahead due to unforeseen circumstances - your deposits will be carried over to a new date.

If you are interested I would love you to join us. We need your deposits paid as soon as possible so we can start working out the final numbers and the itinerary. I know how many of you have enjoyed the snorkelling, stepping outside your comfort zones and doing things that you have never done before on previous cruises and I think this will be one cruise to remember.
